Grant Requests

The foundation cannot make gifts to or for the benefit of an individual. The donee must be and submit proof of being an IRS Section 501 (c) (3) Corporation.

All grant requests must be submitted in writing and as an electronic format (i.e. PDF or Word file) to the Executive Director. Supporting documentation (brochures, annual reports, etc.) must be scanned and attached to your e-mail and sent as a separate package through the US Mail. When submitting your request via US Mail, please forward eight (8) collated sets to the Buffalo Renaissance Foundation address.

Buffalo Renaissance Foundation preference is to provide a definitive amount of funding for a specific expenditure meeting our mission; education, health, cultural or scientific needs of local organization. Operational and administration requests will not be considered. Grant Awards will be subject to follow up and proof of spending on the specific ask.

To be considered for a grant award, you must submit an application and all requirements must be met.

Grant Review Process

All grant applications are reviewed by the Appropriations Committee. The Appropriations Committee makes a final recommendation to be presented to the Board of Directors.

Final approval of the grant application is by Buffalo Renaissance Foundation Board of Directors.
